

By-Law No. 52 1876.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain moneys.
Whereas it is requisite to pay the several sums of money
hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath,
in the County of Renfrew, pursuant to an Act of the Legislature
of Ontario, intituled, "An Act respecting Municipal Institutions in
the Province of Ontario," enacts as follows,—

That Rowell & Hutchison be paid the sum of Five $\frac{62}{100}$
Dollars— Duncan Cameron the sum of Two Dollars,

Joseph Keyes, Collector, on Roll of 1875, for Mrs Hughes,
nine $\frac{85}{100}$ Dollars.

Edward Soran the sum of two Dollars, John

Sullivan the sum of ten dollars, John Evans

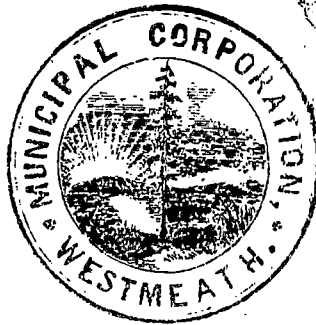
the sum of two dollars, Joseph Keyes on Collectors'
