

By-Law No. 7. — 1876.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money herein - after mentioned,

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, pursuant to an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, intituled, "An Act respecting Municipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario," enacts as follows, that is to say,

That George Suter be paid the sum of Six  $\frac{05}{100}$  Dollars

That Joseph Reyes be paid the sum of One hundred and thirty one  $\frac{35}{100}$  dollars

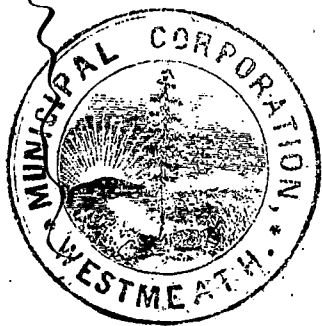
That Samuel Cahill be paid on Collectors Roll of 1875 the sum of Six dollars on acct of Stetute labour improperly charged thereon

That William Wright be paid the sum of Seventy five Dollars
