

By-Law No. 13 - 1876.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money.

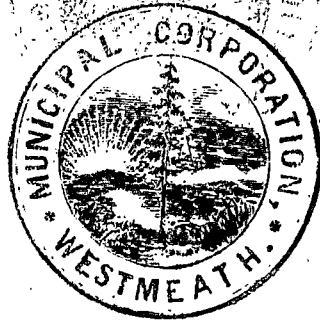
Whereas, it is necessary to pay the several sums of money herein-
after mentioned,

Therefore, The Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath,
in the County of Renfrew, by virtue, and under the authority, of an
Act of the Legislature of Ontario, intituled, "An Act respecting Muni-
cipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario," enacts as follows;

That Samuel Robinson be paid Sixty three Dollars,
James Johnston ~~be paid~~ Ten Dollars, Augustus Brown
Two hundred dollars, Joseph Gracie forty nine dollars
and seventy two cents, R. C. Percival forty one dollars and
twenty four cents, The Pathmaster of Road Division
No. Six ten Dollars, W. Cannon twenty six dollars
and nineteen cents,
