

By-Law No. 14 — 1876.

A By-Law to authorize the levy and Collection of certain Rates in the School Sections (hereinafter mentioned) of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1876.

Whereas, the Trustees of the hereinafter mentioned School Sections within the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, have applied to this Council, to levy and collect upon all the rateable property within their several School Sections, for Special School purposes, for the year 1876, the several sums of money hereunder mentioned, that is to say:— In School Section No. 1, Two hundred and fifty five Dollars; In School Section No. 2, Five hundred and fifty Dollars; In School Section No. 3, Two hundred and eighty five dollars; In School Section No. 4, One hundred and ninety Dollars; In School Section No. 5, — Three hundred and seventy Dollars; In School Section No. 6, One hundred and twenty Dollars; In School Section No. 8, Two hundred and twenty Dollars; In School Section No. 10, One hundred and fifty Dollars; And in School Section No. 11, One hundred and seventy Dollars;

And Whereas, it is also necessary to levy and collect, an additional Rate, (over and above all other rates) in the several School Sections, hereinafter mentioned, to meet the payments on their several School Debentures, issued under the authority of certain By-Laws passed by this Council;

And Whereas, it is necessary to carry out the said applications of the said several School Trustees, and also to levy a Rate, in addition to all other rates, for School Debentures, in the School Sections hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, pursuant to the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, intitled, "An Act to amend and consolidate the Public School Law," enacts as follows, that is to say:—

That the Collector for the said Township of Westmeath, duly appointed, shall levy and collect, and such Collector is hereby required and authorized, to levy and collect upon all the rateable property within the several School Sections — hereinafter mentioned, the several Rates hereinafter mentioned, and to pay over the same when so collected to the Township Treasurer, that is to say:—

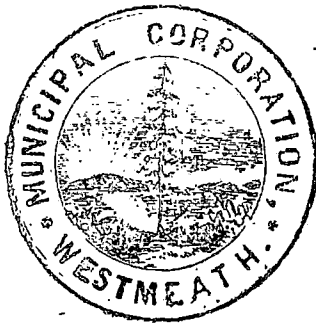
In School Section No. 1, a rate of Six $\frac{45}{100}$ Mills in the Dollar,

In School Section No. 2, a rate of Seven $\frac{45}{100}$ Mills in the Dollar,
 In School Section No. 3, a rate of Six $\frac{16}{100}$ Mills in the Dollar,
 In School Section No. 4, a rate of Eight $\frac{2}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar,
 In School Section No. 5, a rate of Seven $\frac{16}{100}$ Mills in the Dollar,
 In School Section No. 6, a rate of Three $\frac{22}{100}$ Mills in the Dollar,
 In School Section No. 8 a rate of Nine $\frac{7}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar,
 In School Section No. 10, a rate of Eight $\frac{1}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar,
 And in School Section No. 11, a rate of Nine $\frac{7}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar, for
 Special School purposes for 1876; And
 In School Section No. 5, a rate of Five $\frac{94}{100}$ Mills in the Dollar,
 In School Section No. 7, a rate of Three $\frac{64}{100}$ Mills in the Dollar,
 In School Section No. 8, a rate of Five $\frac{80}{100}$ Mills in the Dollar,
 And in School Section No. 11, a rate of Three $\frac{70}{100}$ Mills in the Dollar, to
 meet the payments on School Debentures in the said several
 School Sections; And

that this By-Law shall take effect upon, ~~the~~ from and after
 the passing thereof.
