

By Law No. 15 — 1876.

A By-Law to authorize the levy and collection of certain Rates or Taxes for the year 1876, within the Township of Westmeath.

Whereas, it is necessary to levy and collect upon all the Rateable Property within the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, the several hereinafter mentioned sums of money for the purposes hereinafter specified, that is to say:—

The sum of four hundred and ninety eight dollars and twenty five cents, for General Purposes of the County of Renfrew.

The sum of Nine hundred and ninety six dollars and forty seven cents, for Interest on County Debentures and Sinking Fund.

The sum of Three hundred and eighty eight Dollars for an equivalent to the Government Grant to Schools (Common) within the said Township of Westmeath.

And the sum of Eleven hundred and sixty five Dollars and twenty eight cents for the purposes of the said Township of Westmeath.

And whereas, it is necessary to levy and collect the said several Rates, Taxes or sums of money, for the purposes aforesaid,

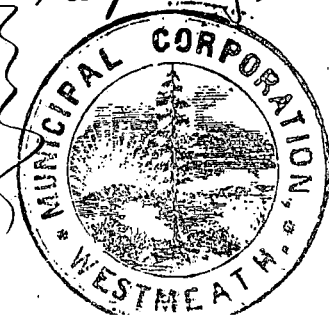
Therefore, the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath, pursuant to the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, intituled, "An Act respecting Municipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario," enacts as follows, that is to say:—

That the Collector for the said Township of Westmeath, duly appointed, shall levy and collect, and such Collector is hereby required and authorized to levy and collect, upon all the rateable property within the said Township of Westmeath, a Rate of one $\frac{200}{1000}$ Mills in the Dollar, for General County purposes; a Rate of Two $\frac{14}{100}$ Mills in the Dollar, for Interest on County Debentures and Sinking Fund. A Rate of $\frac{84}{1000}$ Mills in the Dollar, as an equivalent to the Government Grant to Common Schools in the said Township of Westmeath; And a Rate of Two $\frac{1}{2}$ Mills in the Dollar for Township purposes. And

Passed in open Council the 3^d day of September 1876. That this By-Law shall take effect upon and from the passing thereof.
