

By-Law No. 19. — 1876.

A By-Law to appoint Returning Officers for the Election of Members of the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, for the year 1877, and to establish Polling Places for said Election.

Whereas, it is necessary, in case a Poll be demanded, to appoint Returning Officers to take the Polls at the Municipal Election of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, for the year 1877, and to establish Polling Places for said Election,

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the said County of Renfrew, by virtue, and under the authority, of an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, intituled, "An Act respecting Municipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario," enacts as follows,

That Mr. William Wright — of the said Township of Westmeath, Farmer, be, and is hereby appointed Returning Officer at said Election, for Electoral Division Number One, and that the Polling Place for said Division be the Townhall,

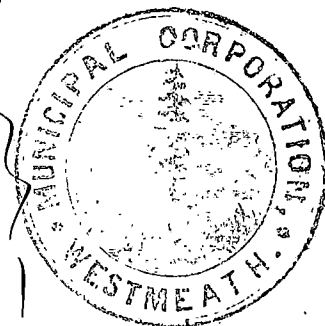
That Mr. Joseph Keyes — of the said Township of Westmeath, Farmer, be, and is hereby appointed Returning Officer at said Election, for Electoral Division Number Two, and that the Polling Place for said Division be the School House in School Section Number One, known as Moores' School House;

And that Mr. John Fraser, — of the said Township of Westmeath, Gentleman, be, and is hereby appointed Returning Officer at said Election, for Electoral Division Number Three, and that the Polling Place for said Division be the School House in School Section Number Two, situate near the Western end of the Gore Line, and commonly known as Front Westmeath School House.
