

By-Law No. 3. — 1877

A By-Law to confirm the appointment of certain Township Officers.

Whereas, it is necessary to appoint certain Township Officers for the Township of Westmeath for the year 1877,

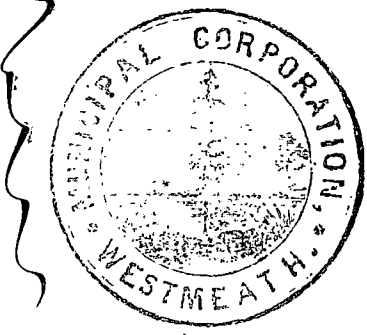
