

By-Law No. 4 — 1877.

A By-Law to establish a Public Road between Lots Numbers Eight and Nine in the Second Concession, West of Muskrat Lake, in the Township of Westmeath:

Whereas, the occupants of the Easterly Halves of Lots Numbers Eight and Nine in the Second Concession, West of Muskrat Lake, in the Township of Westmeath, have represented to this Council, that there is no Road by which they can have ingress and egress to and from their said lands, and have therefore prayed this Council to establish ^{such a Road} on the line between the said Lots from the Blank Line to the edge of their said lands:

And whereas it is necessary to establish such Road:

And whereas a Notice of the intention of this Council to pass a By-Law to establish such Road, which Notice also contained a description of such Road, was duly published for four successive weeks in the "Pembroke Observer" Newspaper; and six copies of such Notice and description of Road were duly ^{in the immediate vicinity of} posted up, at least ^{said intended Road,} one month before the passing of this By-Law;

And whereas, the County Council of the County of Renfrew in the Province of Ontario, did, at its Session of January last past, pass a By-Law, by which authority was granted, to the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the said County of Renfrew, to establish, within the limits of the said Township of Westmeath, Public Roads of a less width than sixty-six feet:

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, by virtue, and under the authority, of an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, intituled, "An Act respecting Municipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario", and of a By-Law of the County Council of the County of Renfrew passed at its Session in the month of January A.D. 1877, enacts as follows, viz —

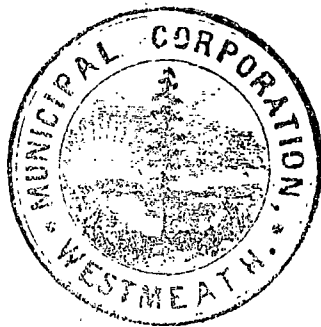
That the Road hereinafter described, that is to say, Commencing on the Easterly side of the Blank Line between the First and Second Concessions, West of Muskrat Lake, in the said Township of Westmeath, at the dividing line between Lots Numbers Eight and Nine in the Second Concession West of Muskrat Lake in the said Township, — thence, Easterly along the said dividing line, and embracing a uniform

width of land, on each side of said Dividing Line, of twenty feet, to the line dividing the East and West Halves of the said Lots Numbers Eight and Nine in the said Second Concession West of Muskrat Lake in the said Township of Westmeath," be, and is hereby declared to be a Public Road, and that said Public Road be opened up, and rendered passable so soon as conveniently may be; And that this By-Law do take effect from and upon the passing thereof.
