

By-Law No. 14 - 1877

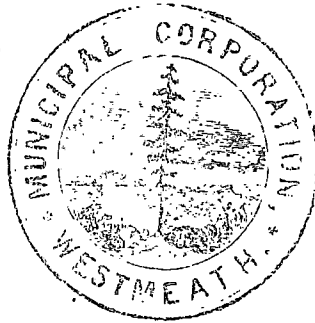
A By-Law to close up the old Road through the Lands of Mr. Toussaint Cecil on Lots Nos. 10 & 11 in Concession West-Front C. in the Township of Westmeath.

Whereas it is necessary to close up the old Road through the Lands of Mr. Toussaint Cecil in the Township of Westmeath, therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, by virtue and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Ontario, intituled, "An Act respecting Municipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario," enacts as follows.

That Mr. Cecil having given a Deed of a <sup>new</sup> Road through ~~his~~ between his Lands <sup>Lots</sup> Nos. 10. & 11. in the West Front C. Concession in the Township of Westmeath in lieu of the old road which passed through the said Lots, which said new Road is now completed and opened up for public travel and the said old road is of no further use as a Public Road, the said old road is hereby closed up, and becomes from the date hereof, the private property of the said Toussaint Cecil.
