

By-Law No. 15 - 1877.

A By-Law to appoint a Returning Officer and Three Deputy Returning Officers to hold the Election for Members of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1878, and to establish the Places for the Nomination and for Polling at the said Election

Whereas, it is necessary, ~~for a Poll to be demanded~~ (to appoint Officers to hold the Nomination Meeting and to take the Polls (in case a Poll be demanded) at the Municipal Election for the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, for the Election of Members of the Council of the said Municipality for the year 1878, and to establish the Place for holding the Nomination of Candidates for each Council and also the Places for taking the Polls at said Election.

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, by Virtue and under the authority of an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, intituled, "An Act ^{to amend an act} respecting Municipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario", enacts as follows:

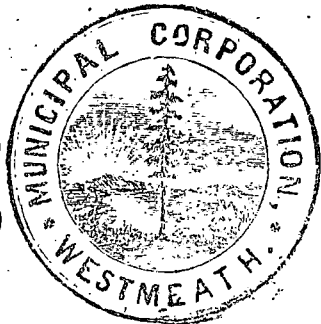
That the Clerk, W. Cannon, be and is hereby appointed Returning Officer at said Election and to preside at the Nomination Meeting to be held in the Townhall for said Election.

That Mr. William Wright of the said Township of Westmeath, Collector, be, and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division Number One, and that the Townhall be the Polling Place for said Electoral Division.

That Mr. Joseph Keyes of the said Township of Westmeath, Assessor, be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division Number Two, and that the School House in School Section Number One of the said Township of Westmeath, known as Moore's School House, be the Polling Place for said Electoral Division.

And that Mr. John Fraser of the said Township of Westmeath, Merchant, be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division Number Three, and that the School House in School Section Number Two of the said Township, known as Front Westmeath School House, be the Polling Place for said Electoral Division.
