

By-Law No. 2. — 1878.

A By-law to form a new School Section out of parts of School Sections Numbers Two and Three in the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew.

Whereas, application has been made to this Council by Martin Hennessy, for himself, and for other persons interested in the said application, to form a new School Section out of parts of School Sections Numbers Two and Three, in the Township of Westmeath,

And Whereas, the Trustees of said School Sections Numbers Two and Three have been duly notified by the Clerk of this Council, of such application, and of the intention of this Council to act upon such application at its sitting on Saturday the Second day of March A. D. 1878,

And Whereas, the said several parties, or such of them as have appeared personally, or by their agents, have been duly heard, and the whole of the circumstances of the case or application having been duly considered by this Council; and this Council, having duly considered the statements made by the said parties, deem it proper and expedient to form a new School Section out of parts of the hereinbefore mentioned School Sections as hereinafter set forth,

Therefore, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of said Township of Westmeath, pursuant to the powers given to them by "the public Schools Act" of the Province of Ontario and "the Act respecting Municipal Institutions in ^{the} said Province, of Ontario" enact as follows,

That Lots Numbers thirteen to thirty, both included, in the West Front E. Concession, Lots Numbers eleven, twelve and thirteen in Concession A. and Lots eleven to sixteen, both included, in Concession B: all of said Lots and Concessions, fronting on Coulonge Lake, in the aforesaid Township of Westmeath, be and are hereby detached from School Section Number Two of said Township of Westmeath, and that the same be and are hereby formed into a part of a new School Section to be known and designated as School Section Number Thirteen of said Township; That the West Half of Lot Number Six, Lots Number seven, eight, nine and ten in Concession A.

and

and Lot Number Ten in the First Concession, all of said
Lots and Concessions, Fronting on Coulouge Lake, in the afore-
said Township of Westmeath, be and are hereby detached from
School Section Number Three of the said Township of Westmeath,
and that the same be and are hereby formed into ^{another} part of a new
School Section to be known and designated as School Section
Number Thirteen of said Township; said parts ^{together} to form school section
^{number thirteen}
That all By-Laws or Parts of By-Laws contrary to the provisions
of this By-Law ^{heretofore made} be and are hereby repealed.
And that this By-Law shall take effect from and after the
twenty fifth day of December now next ensuing the passing
thereof.

Sir.

I beg to inform you that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, did, on Saturday, the Second day of March 1878, pass a By-law to detach parts of School Sections Numbers Two and Three in the said Township, from said Sections, and therewith to form a new School Section to be known and designated as School Section Number Thirteen of Westmeath, said By-law to take effect from and after the twenty fifth day of December, 1878.

The following is a description of the lands taken from each Section, viz - Lots Number Thirteen to thirty, both included, in the west front E. Concession, fronting on Coulange Lake; Lots Numbers Eleven, Twelve and Thirteen in A. Concession, C. L. F.; and Lots Numbers Eleven to sixteen, both included, in B. Concession, C. L. F., from said School Section Number Two;

The West Half of Lot Number Six, Lots Numbers Seven, eight, Nine and Ten in A. Concession, C. L. F.; and Lot Number Ten in the First Concession, C. L. F., from said School Section Number Three - and forming altogether School Section Number Thirteen as above mentioned.
