

# By-law No. 13. 1881

A By-Law to appoint a <sup>Election</sup> Returning Officer and Three Deputy Returning Officers to hold the Elections for Members of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the Year 1882, and to establish the place for the nomination and for Polling at the said Election.

Whereas it is necessary to appoint officers to hold the Meeting and to take the Polls (in case a Poll be demanded) at the Municipal Election for the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, for the Election of Members of the Council of the said Municipality for the Year 1882, and to Establish the place for holding the Nomination of Candidates for such Council, and also the places for taking the Polls at the said Election.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew by Virtue and under the Authority of an act of the Legislature of Ontario intituled "an act to amend an act respecting Municipal Institutions in the province of Ontario" enacts as follows:-

That the Clerk Archibald Cameron, be and is hereby appointed Returning Officer at said Election and to preside at the Nomination Meeting to be held in the Townhall for said Election, -

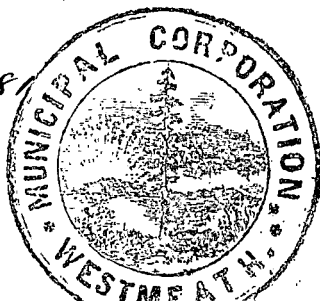
That Abel Beach of the said Township of Westmeath Farmer, be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division Number One and that the Townhall be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division,

That Duncan Cameron of the said Township of Westmeath Farmer, be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division Number Two and that the School House in school Section Number One of the said Township of Westmeath Known as Moore's School house, be the Polling place for said Electoral Division, -

And that Gideon Adams of the said Township of Westmeath Agent be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division Number Three and that the School House in School Section Number Two situated near the Western end of the Gore Line, and commonly known as Front Westmeath School House, be the Polling place for said Electoral Division, -
