

By Law No. 7. 1883.

A. by Law to open up an allowance of Road across the Seventh Concession between Lots Number Twenty and Twenty one, and across the Sixth Concessions until it intersects <sup>with</sup> the Pembroke Road between Lots Number Twenty and Twenty one, in the Township of Westmeath County of Renfrew,

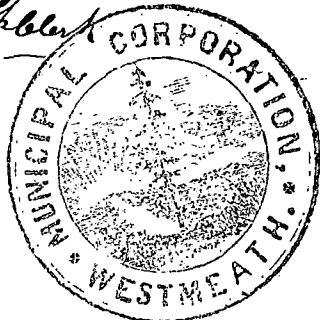
Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew pursuant of the powers given to them by the Municipal Act of Ontario enacts as follows,

That the said Road between Lots 20 and 21 across the 7th Concession and across the Sixth Concession between ~~the~~ <sup>lots</sup> 20 and 21 ~~as far as the~~ to where the line intersects with the Pembroke Road, be opened on or before the First day of November 1884, and all parties refusing or neglecting to have all fences or obstructions removed at said date ~~any person making a complaint~~ before the Peace or any Justice of the Peace in the County of Renfrew will be liable to be fined in a sum not less than One dollar or more than Twenty dollars said fine to be levied by distress upon the goods and Chattles of the offender and if no distress can be found to be committed to jail until the fine and costs are paid time not to exceed Twenty days,
