

To All To whom these Presents shall
Come We John Deacon of the Town
of Humberstone in the County of Hampshire
Esquire, Judge of the County Court
the County of Hampshire, John Dooner
of the Township of Bromley in the said
County of Hampshire Esquire, Warden
the said County of Hampshire and
William Selkirk of the Township of
Mettawa in the said County of
Hampshire Esquire and Gentling

Know ye that whereas more than five
of the ratepayers of school section number
five in the Township of Westmeath in the
County of Hampshire made application to the
Township Council of the said Township
to alter the boundaries of the said section
and of school section number six in the
said Township and to form a new section
out of parts of the said two sections

And whereas the said Township Council
has neglected and refused in any legal
or valid manner to alter the said
boundaries or to form any new school
section as asked for in the said
application

And whereas more than five of the
ratepayers of the said school sections
numbers five and six appealed to the
County Council of the County of Hampshire
being the County in which the said
Township is situated against the said
neglect and refusal of the said
Township Council

And whereas the said County Council
did duly appoint us the said John
Deacon, John Dooner and William Selkirk
and Robert George Scott Justices of

Public Schools for the said County of Niagara
 Arbitrators to revise determine or alter
 the boundaries of the said school sections
 and to settle the matters complained of by
 the said ratepayers pursuant to the
 provisions of The Public Schools Act 1845

And whereas the said Robert George Scott
 hath declined to act as such arbitrator and
 as the said John Deam John Dooner and
 William Selkirk are a majority of all the
 said arbitrators so appointed by the said
 County Council as aforesaid

And whereas due notice has been
 given to all parties concerned of a
 meeting of us the said first named
 three arbitrators to be holden at the Court
 House in the said Town of Leamington
 Friday the thirtieth day of July A.D. 1886
 for the purpose of hearing and deter-
 mining the matters so complained of
 by the said ratepayers as aforesaid

And whereas at the day and place
 last aforesaid a meeting of us the said
 three arbitrators was duly held for the
 purposes aforesaid and the said
 ratepayers were also present by themselves
 and by Michael James Gorman Esquire
 their Counsel and the Trustees of said
 school section number five were also
 present by themselves and by William R.
 White their Counsel and certain of the
 ratepayers of the said school section
 number six were also present by
 themselves

Now know ye that we the said John
 Deam, John Dooner and William
 Selkirk having taken upon ourselves
 the burden of the said arbitration
 and having heard and considered

The evidence of the witnesses given on oath before us at the time and place aforesaid and what was alleged by counsel aforesaid, ^{and} by the said ratepayers who were not represented by counsel do make this our award order and arbitrament of and concerning the matters so referred to us as aforesaid in the manner following, that is to say: -

1. We order award and determine that a new school ^{section} be and the same is hereby formed in the said Township, to be called School Section number fourteen, and that the boundaries thereof shall include lots numbers nine to twelve inclusive in the sixth seventh eighth and ninth concessions and lots numbers twelve to twenty two both inclusive in East Front B concession of the said Township of Westmeath and no more

2. And we further order award and determine that the boundaries of the said School Section number six be and the same are hereby altered so as to include lot number seven in the seventh concession and lots numbers ~~six~~ eight in the sixth seventh and eighth concessions of the said Township of Westmeath

3. And we further order award and determine that the boundaries of the said School Section number five be and the same are hereby altered so as to exclude from the said section all the said lots of land heretofore ordered to form parts of the said new section and of the said section number six

4. And we do further order award and determine that the boundaries of the said School Section number six

be and the same are hereby further altered
so as to exclude therefrom all those lots of
land heretofore forming a part thereof
but hereinbefore ordered to form a part of the
said new section.

5. And we further order award and
determine that there are no other matters in
difference between the said parties to us
referred.

thirtieth day of July in the year of our
