

By-Law No. 6. 1887  
To Appoint Township Officers for the year 1887.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Roscommon -

That from and after the 1st day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, the persons hereinafter mentioned as Overseers of Highways, Fence Divers and Pound Keepers for the several Road Divisions of the Municipality of Westmeath be, and they are hereby constituted and appointed to fill the said respective offices as set forth in the Schedules hereunto annexed, Marked as follows, - A. Overseers of Highways, B. Fence Divers, C. Poundkeepers. -

That each of the said officers hereby appointed shall on or before the first day of May 1887, next after the passing of this By-Law, make and subscribe the necessary declarations of office and shall continue to hold such respective office as aforesaid, until his or their successor has been duly appointed and qualified, or until otherwise relieved by this Council.

And be it further enacted,

That the Schedules A. B. C. hereunto annexed shall form and be a part of this By-Law,
