

By Law No. 13, 1888,

To open and establish an original allowance for road, Between Lots Number 30 N. F. A, and 20 and 21 on the 6th Concession E. M. L. of the Township of Westmeath to the Pembroke Road.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath.

That whereas application has been made to this Council by Lewis Bourke and others praying that a By-law may be passed for opening a certain original allowance for road, situate Between Lot Number 30 N. F. A, and 20, and 21, on the 6th Concession E. M. L. of the said Municipality;

And, whereas notice in writing has been given to all persons in possession of any portion of said original allowance for road, as provided by the Municipal Act of the Revised Statute of Ontario, of the intention of this Council to open said road,

And, whereas all persons whose land might be prejudicially affected by the opening of said road have been heard who petitioned to be so heard.

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath,

That all that portion of the Government or original allowance for road, comprising all and singular, that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the Township of Westmeath and Province of Ontario, being composed of the original allowance for road, situate ~~between~~ <sup>Between</sup> Lots Number 30, N. F. A, and 20 and 21, on the 6th Concession E. M. L. of the said Municipality and which is more particularly described as follows

The Allowance of Road between Lot Number 30 N. F. A, and 20, and 21, on the 6th Concession from Pembroke Road to Bellows Bay, be and the same is hereby opened and established for public use.
