Township of Westmeath as follows. -

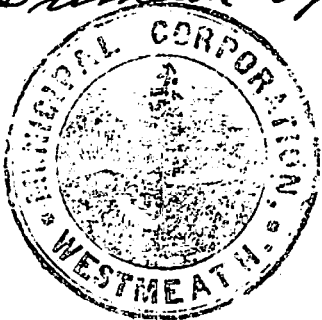
That the votes be taken by the Deputy returning officers
