

By Law No. 4, 1890. —

To Fix the duties payable for Tavern and Shop Licenses  
in the Township of Westmeath,

Whereas by an act of the Provincial Legislature of Ontario passed in the  
Thirty ninth year of Her Majesty's reign intituled, an Act to amend  
The Law respecting the sale of fermented or Spirituous Liquors,  
And whereas by the said Act power is given to the Municipal Corporation  
to require by By Law a larger duty to be paid for Licenses than  
that prescribed by Law, It enacts as follows —

1. That the duty payable for a Tavern License shall be the sum  
of One Hundred ~~and~~ Dollars which sum shall include  
the amount payable to the Government;
2. That the duty payable for a Shop License shall be One Hundred  
and Thirty Dollars which sum shall include the amount  
payable to the Government,

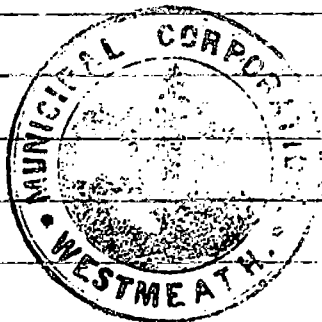
That all By Laws and part of By Laws  
inconsistent with this by Law are hereby repealed.
