

By Law No. 14, 1890

To Assess and Levy Rates or Taxes for County, Township General School Rates and Special School Purposes for the year 1890,

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew,

That the following sums shall be levied and collected upon and from all the rateable property of the Township of Westmeath for the year of our Lord 1890.

The sum of

dollars is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property of the said Township of Westmeath for County Purposes for the year of our Lord 1890 by a rate of  $5\frac{1}{4}$  Mills in the dollar.

The sum of

dollars is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property of the said Township of Westmeath for Township purposes for the year of our Lord 1890 by a rate of  $4\frac{3}{4}$  Mills in the dollar.

And the further sum of

dollars is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property of the said Township of Westmeath for General School purposes of the County of Renfrew for the year of our Lord 1890 by a rate of

1 Mill in the Dollar.

And be it further enacted,

That the following sums shall be levied and collected upon and from all the rateable property included within the limits of the several School Sections hereinafter mentioned respectively for the year of our Lord 1890 namely.

1. In S. S. No. 1. The sum of Two Hundred and Seventy Dollars and Thirtieth Cent is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property within the limits of S. S. No. One by a rate of ~~11~~ <sup>two</sup> Mills in the Dollar.

2. In S. S. No. 2. The sum of Five Hundred and Seventy Dollars and Fifty Two cents is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property within the limits of said S. S. No. Two by a rate of  $1\frac{3}{4}$  Mills in the Dollar.

3. In S. S. No. 3. The sum of Two Hundred and fifty Six Dollars and Eighty one cent is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property within the limits of said S. S. No. Three by a rate of 9 Mills in the Dollar.

4. In S. S. No. 4. The sum of One Hundred and Sixty three Dollars

- and Ten cents is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property situated within the limits of said S.S. No. 4, by a rate of 10 Mills in the Dollar,
5. In S.S. No. 5, The sum of Two Hundred and Twenty eight Dollars and fifteen cents is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property situated within the limits of said S.S. No. Five by a rate of 13 Mills in the Dollar,
6. In S.S. No. 6. The sum of One Hundred and Seventy four Dollars and Sixteen Cents is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property situated within the limits of said S.S. No. Six by a rate of 8 Mills in the Dollar,
7. In S.S. No. 7. The sum of One Hundred and Thity Six Dollars and Ninety four cents is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property situated within the limits of said S.S. No. Seven by a rate of 13 Mills in the Dollar,
8. In S.S. No. 8. The sum of ~~Two~~ One Hundred and Seventy five Dollars and fourteen Cents is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property situated within the limits of said S.S. No. Eight by a rate of 15 Mills in the Dollar,
9. In S.S. No. 9. The sum of Two Hundred and Forty four Dollars is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property situated within the limits of said S.S. No. Nine by a rate of 20 Mills in the Dollar,
10. In S.S. No. 10. The sum of One Hundred and Eighty Three Dollars and fifteen cents is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property situated within the limits of said S.S. No. Ten by a rate of 18 Mills in the Dollar,
11. In S.S. No. 11. The sum of Two Hundred and Thiry-Eight dollars and thirty eight cents is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property situated within the limits of said S.S. No. Eleven by a rate of 12 Mills in the Dollar,
12. In S.S. No. 12. The sum of Two Hundred and fourteen Dollars and Sixty Seven cents is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property situated within the limits of said S.S. No. Twelve by a rate of 11 Mills in the Dollar,
13. In S.S. No. 13. The sum of One Hundred and Forty Six Dollars and Fifty Two cents is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property situated within the limits of said S.S. No. Thirteen by a rate of 18 Mills in the Dollar.

14. In S. S. No. 14, the sum of Two Hundred and Two Dollars and  
Ten cents is hereby levied upon and shall be collected  
from all the rateable property situated within the limits of said  
S. S. No. 14 by a rate of 10 Mills in the Dollar.

And be it further enacted

That the following sum shall be levied and collected upon and from  
all the rateable property included within the limits of School section Number  
Two by a rate of 5½ Mills in the Dollar for paying Debentures  
in said School Section for Building a New School House the sum  
required is Two Hundred and forty Two Dollars and Twenty Two cents

S. S. No. Three, by a rate of 6 Mills in the Dollar for paying Debentures  
on said School Section for Building a New School House the sum  
required is One Hundred and Seventy one Dollars and Twenty one cents

S. S. No. Five by a rate of 11½ Mills in the Dollar for paying Debentures  
on said School Section for Building a New School house the sum  
required is Two Hundred and one Dollars and Eighty Two cents

S. S. No. Eleven by a rate of 7 Mills in the Dollar for paying Debentures  
on said School Section for Building a New School house the sum  
required is One Hundred and Thirteen Dollars and five cents


S. S. No. Fourteen by a rate of 6½ Mills in the Dollar for paying Debentures  
on said School Section for Building a new School House the sum  
required is One Hundred and Thirteen Dollars and ~~thirty six~~ <sup>Cents</sup> D~~ollars~~  
And be it further enacted that the rate imposed by this By Law shall be  
Collected and paid over to the Treasurers of this Corporation in Bankable funds  
on or before the Thirteenth day of December 1890 by the Collector of  
rates for the said Township of Westmeath in so far as the law will  
enable him so to do.
