

By Law No. 2. 1891.

A by law to appoint a Returning Officer and Four Deputy Returning Officers to hold the Election for ~~Local Officer~~ <sup>the prohibiting of</sup> the sale of intoxicating liquors within the limits of ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> municipality ~~and may submit the same to the electors for~~ <sup>ification, and for the year 1891. and to establish the place for</sup> the nomination and for Polling at said Election.

Whereas it is necessary to appoint officers to hold the meeting and to take the Polls at the said Election for the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew for the Election for 1891 and to establish the place for holding the ~~meeting of election~~ for the By Law and also the place for taking the Polls at said Election.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew by virtue and under the Authority of an act of the Legislature of Ontario intituled an Act Respecting Municipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario enacts as follows:

That the Clerk asst. Chas. Corbett be and is hereby appointed Returning Officer at said Election ~~and at said~~

That Hugh Dunsen of the said Township of Westmeath Esq. be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returng Officer at said Election for Electoral Division Number One and that the Town Hall be the polling place for said Electoral Division.

That James Arnsby of the said Township of Westmeath Farmer be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division Number Two and that the School House in School Section Number One of the said Township of Westmeath known as Mowat School House be the Polling place for said Electoral Division.

That S. Huntington of the said Township of Westmeath Esq. be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division Number Three and that the Public Hall at Front Westmeath be the polling place for said Electoral Division.

And that Geo Douglas of the said Township of Westmeath Merchant be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returng Officer

Office at said Election for Electoral Division Number  
Four and that the Schoolhouse known as  
Lees Schoolhouse be the polling place for said  
Electoral Division.
