

## By Law No. 4, 1891

A by-law to prohibit the sale of Intoxicating Liquors within the limits of the Municipality of Westmeath,

1. Read the First and Second times the 19th day of January 1891.

Whereas the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew have resolved,

2. That whereas it is provided by the Statutes of Ontario Ch. 53, Chap. 56 Sec 18, that the Council of any Municipality may pass a by-law for the prohibiting the sale of intoxicating liquors within the limits of such Municipality and may submit the same to the electors for ratification,

3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on and after the First day of May A.D. 1891,

And whereas this by-law requires the assent of the electors of the Township of Westmeath before the final passing thereof,

And whereas it is necessary to appoint a time and places for taking a poll of the electors upon the proposed by-law and also a day for finally considering the said by-law in Council

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath as follows,

That the votes of the electors of the said Township of Westmeath shall be taken by the Deputy returning officers hereinafter named on the Wednesday the 25th day of February A.D. 1891 commencing at nine o'clock in the forenoon and continuing until five o'clock in the afternoon of the same day at the undermentioned places - that is to say,

Polling Sub-division No. 1, Polling place at Town hall Beachburg, Deputy Returning Officer Hugh R. Dunn,

Polling Sub-division No. 2, Polling place at Moors Schoolhouse Deputy Returning Officer James Arnaley,

Polling Sub-division No. 3, Polling place at Public Hall Westmeath Front, Deputy Returning Officer Samuel Huntington,

Polling Sub-division No. 4, Polling place at Lee's School House Deputy Returning Officer George Douglas,

That the Reeve of the Township of Westmeath will on the 20th day of February A.D. 1891, at the Council Chamber in the Townhall in Beachburg, at Ten o'clock in the forenoon

appoint in writing signed by him Two persons to attend at the final summing up of votes by the Clerk and one person to attend at each polling place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of promoting the passing of this by law and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of opposing the passage thereof.

That the Clerk of the said Township of Westmeath shall sum up the number of votes given for and against this By law on the 26th day of February A.D. 1891, at Ten o'clock in the forenoon in the Townhall at the Village of Beachburg and that the by law will be finally considered by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath at the said Town Hall on the 28th day of February A.D. 1891,
