

# By Law No. 5, 1891,

A by-law to prohibit the sale of Spirituous, Fermented or other Manufactured Liquors within the limits of the Municipality of Westmeath.

Whereas a numerous signed petition of the ratepayers and others of the Municipality of the Township of Westmeath has been presented to the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath, requesting that a by-law be passed by the said Council to prohibit the sale of, by retail of spirituous, fermented, or other manufactured liquors in said municipality, as provided by 53 Vic. Chap. 56, Sec 18 of the Statutes of Ontario,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in Council assembled, enacts as follows,

1. That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to sell by retail any spirituous, fermented or other manufactured liquors, in any tavern, inn or other house, or place of public entertainment, within the Municipality of the Township of Westmeath.
2. That the sale of spirituous, fermented or other manufactured liquors, in shops within the Municipality of the Township of Westmeath, is hereby absolutely prohibited.
3. That this by-law shall take effect on, from, and after the first day of May A.D. 1891,
4. That a Poll shall be open for taking the votes of the electors in the several polling subdivisions of the said Municipality at nine o'clock in the morning, on Friday, the 27th day of February, A.D. 1891, and continuing until Five o'clock in the afternoon of the same day.
5. That the said several polls shall be held at or near the following places,  
 Polling Subdivision No. 1, Polling place at Town hall Beachburg,  
 Polling Subdivision No. 2, Polling place at Moore's Schoolhouse,  
 Polling Subdivision No. 3, Polling place at Public hall Westmeath,  
 Polling Subdivision No. 4, Polling place at Lees School House,
6. That the following persons shall be and the same are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers for the respective polling subdivisions, Viz.  
 Hugh R. Dunn Polling Subdivision No. 1,  
 James Ormsby " " " " " 2,  
 Samuel Huntington jr " " " " " 3,  
 George Douglas " " " " " 4,
7. That Thomas Fraser Esq. Reeve of the said Municipality of Westmeath, will attend on the 20th day of February A.D. 1891, at the Council

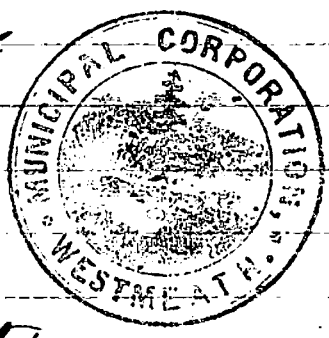
Chambers in the Townhall in Beachburg, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, for the purpose of appointing two persons to attend at the final summing up of the votes, and one person to attend at each polling place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of the passing of this by-law, and a like ~~number~~ number on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of opposing the passing of this by-law.

8. That the Clerk of the Municipality of the said Township of Westmeath, will attend at the Council Chambers in the Town Hall of the Township of Westmeath on the 28th day of February A.D. 1891, at ten o'clock in the forenoon and shall then and there in the presence of the agents, or other persons appointed for that purpose, sum up the number of votes for and against the said by-law,
