

By-Law Number 8, 1892,

To open and establish a Road upon and across ^{parts of} Lots Number 14 and 15, on the 2nd Concession W. M. L. of the Township of Westmeath,
Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew,

That, whereas this Council has determined and agreed to open and establish a road upon and ^{parts of} across Lots Number 14 and 15 on the 2nd Concession W. M. L. of the Township of Westmeath, forty feet wide, as hereinafter set forth and described,

And whereas this Council has caused all Notices to be given, as required by the Municipal Act of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, of the intention of this Council to open said Road,

And, whereas all persons whose lands might be prejudicially affected by the opening of said road have been heard who petitioned to be so heard,

And, whereas no objections were made to the opening of the said road,
Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, that the parcel of land or road deviation, comprising ^{all} and ~~and~~ singular, that part of Lots Number 14 and 15 on the Second Concession, W. M. L. in the Township of Westmeath, Road bed to be forty feet wide, to start from a post planted Marked A, on the old Established road running in a north-westerly direction 29 chains to a post marked B, thence in a westerly direction 7 chains where it again intersects the old established road, ~~by~~ and the same is hereby opened and established for public use as a road and Public highway of and for the said Municipality of Westmeath,
