

By Law No. 21. - 1892.

A by law to appoint a Returning Officer and four Deputy Returning Officers to hold the elections for members of the Council of the Municipality Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1893. and to establish the place for the nominations and for Polling at said election,

Whereas it is necessary to appoint officers to hold the meeting and to take the Polls (in case a Poll be demanded) at the Municipal Election for the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, for the Election of Members of the Council of the said Municipality for the year 1893 and to establish the place for holding the nomination of Candidates for such Council and also the place for taking the Polls, at the said Election,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew by virtue and under the authority of an act of the Legislature of Ontario intitled an act respecting Municipal Institutions of the Province of Ontario enacts as follows,

That the Clerk Archibald Cameron be and is hereby appointed Returning Officer at said Election and to preside at the nomination meeting to be held in the Townhall for said Election,

That Abel Beach of the said Township of Westmeath Farmer be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division Number One and that the Townhall be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division,

That James Crossley of the said Township of Westmeath Farmer be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division Number Two and that the Schoolhouse in School Section Number One of the said Township of Westmeath known as Moores Schoolhouse be the polling place for said Electoral Division,

That Eldon Adams of the said Township of Westmeath ~~Farmer~~ be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said ^{Election} ~~meeting~~ for Electoral Division Number Three and that the

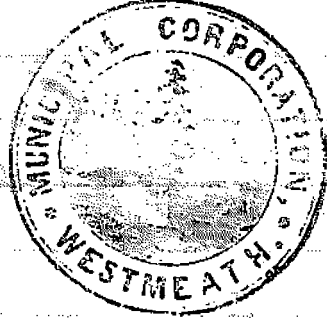
Public Hall at Front Westmeath be the Polling place for said Electoral Division

And that, George Douglas of the said Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed, Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division number Four and that the School House in School Section Number Eight known as Lees School House be the Polling place for said Electoral Division,
