

Pembroke, Ont., July 8th, 1893.

I, James L. Morris, the Engineer appointed by the Municipality of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew under the provisions of the Ditches and Watercourses Act having by the Requisition of Maxime Dupuis, owner of Lot No. 9 in Con. 1, C. L. F., David Bromley, owner of Lot No. 9 in Con. 2 C. L. F., John La Pine, owner of Lot No. 8 in Con. 2 C. L. F., John Lefrenier, owner of Lot No. 7 in Con. 2 C. L. F., Robert Gordon, of Lot No. 8 in Con. 3, C. L. F., all in the Township of Westmeath, filed with the Clerk of the said Municipality, representing that they required a ditch or drain through their respective Lots. did attend at the place named in said notice, and having examined the localities of said ditches or drains and heard the parties, find and award as follows:-

That Lot No. 8 in the 2nd Con. of the Township of Westmeath would be benefited by and requires a ditch or drain to enable the proper cultivation or use of the said land and I find that the said ditch or drain will require to be extended across the land of John La Pine, being Lot No. 8 in the 2nd Con. C. L. F., and along the Road allowance between Con. 1 and Con. 2 C. L. F., and across the lands of Maxime Dupuis being Lot No. 9 in the 1st Con. C. L. F., of the Township of Westmeath - and I award the making of said ditch or drain as follows:-

John Lefrenier shall commence at Stake, marked A Q (as per plan annexed) and marked $\frac{1}{2}$ and shall open up and maintain a ditch three feet deep and five feet in width with sloping sides, by deepening the present watercourse, to a stake

marked $\overline{10-00}$ (as shown on plan 1). John La Pine shall commence at stake marked $\overline{10-00}$ and shall open up and maintain a ditch of depths as shown on annexed profile marked $\overline{1}$ five feet wide with sloping banks to a stake marked $\overline{14-00}$ C.

The Municipality of Westmeath shall build a culvert with opening not less than $3'6" \times 4'6"$ at place shown on plan marked $\overline{7}$ and shall excavate and maintain a ditch from stake marked $\overline{6}$ across the road and thence along the North side of the road allowance to a stake marked $\overline{12+00}$, the depth to be as shown on profile marked $\overline{1}$, with a width of five feet. John La Pine to begin at stake marked $\overline{12+00}$ and excavate and maintain a ditch along the North side of road allowance to a stake marked $\overline{20+54}$ C to depths as shown on profile marked $\overline{7}$ and with a width of five feet. David Bromley to begin at a stake marked $\overline{20+54}$ C and excavate and maintain a ditch through Maxime Dupuis's field to a stake marked $\overline{10+00}$ with depths as shown on profile marked $\overline{1}$ and with a width of five feet; Maxime Dupuis to begin at stake marked $\overline{10+00}$ and excavate and maintain a ditch to stake marked $\overline{19+40}$ G. at edge of slough, to depth as shown on profile marked "1" and with a width of five feet. Also to excavate outlet from slough along watercourse with a depth beginning at $2'6"$ and finishing at $3'6"$ and a width of five feet. John La Pine and David Bromley to keep surface drains N. Q. T. and R. S. I. through their respective lots open to the basins for the free flow of water. Also David Bromley shall excavate and maintain

a ditch three feet wide, (as shown on plan marked "3") to the side line between Lots 8 and 9 Con. 26, 27, 28. John LaBine shall excavate and maintain a ditch as shown on plan marked "2", three feet wide from the side line between Lots 8 and 9 to a stake marked "C". - The Municipality of Westmeath shall build a culvert between C and A as shown on plan 3' x 4' 6" and shall excavate and maintain ditch four feet wide between these points. - John LeFrenier shall excavate and maintain a ditch four feet wide beginning at stake marked "A" for a distance of four hundred feet towards "B". - Robert Gordon shall excavate and maintain a ditch four feet wide from where John LeFrenier finishes to a stake marked "B" and from stake marked "B" to stake marked "C" in Watercourse. - David Bromley shall open up and widen the watercourse to a width of four feet for a distance of three hundred feet. - John LaBine shall open up and widen the watercourse to a width of four feet from where David Bromley ends for a distance of five hundred feet. - John LeFrenier shall open up the watercourse to a width of four feet from where John LaBine ends for a distance of four hundred feet. - Robert Gordon shall open up the watercourse to a width of four feet from where John LaFrenier ends for a distance of four hundred feet.

All depths of excavation to be according to profile marked.

All work shall be completed within two months and fifteen days from the date of this award.

That any costs attendant upon the examination and making of this award are Forty dollars and fifty cents and shall be borne, as follows:-
