A By-Law for the appointment of an engineer
under the Ditches and Watercourses Act- 1894
Finally passed

The Municipal Council of the Township
of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew
enact as follows:

1 Pursuant to the provisions of section
4 of the Ditches and Watercourses Act- 1894

J. L. Morris of the Town of Pembroke
in the County of Renfrew is hereby appointed
as the Engineer for this Municipality
to carry out the provisions of the said Act

2 The said engineer shall be paid
the sum of Five dollars which sum
shall include travelling expenses
Per day

3 This by-Law shall take effect from
and after the formal passing thereof
