

By-Law No. 19 1895

To open and establish an original allowance for road between Lot Number 30 N. F. A. and part of Lot Number 17 and <sup>also</sup> Lots 18, 19, 20, and 21 in the 6<sup>th</sup> Concession of the Township of Westmeath East of the Muskoka Lake

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath: That whereas application has been made to this council by Benjamin Mason and others praying that a By-Law maybe passed for the opening of a certain original allowance for road situate between lot number 30 N. F. A. and part of 17 and also 18, 19, 20, and 21 in the 6<sup>th</sup> concession of the said Township of Westmeath East of the Muskoka Lake

And whereas notice in writing has been given to all persons in possession of any portion of said original allowance for road as provided by the Municipal Act of the revised Statutes of Ontario of the intention of this council to open said road And whereas all persons whose land might be prejudicially affected by the opening of said road have been heard who petitioned to be so heard

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath That all that portion of the Government or original allowance for road comprising all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the Township of Westmeath and Province of Ontario being composed of the original allowance for road situate between Lot Number 30 N. F. A. and part of 17 to 21 inclusive in the 6<sup>th</sup> Concession East of the Muskoka Lake of the said Township of Westmeath and which

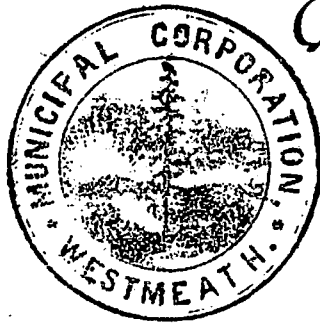
said allowance for road between Lots  
Number 30 N.F.A and Lots 17 to 21  
inclusive in the 6<sup>th</sup> Concession in the Township  
of Westmeath Co. M. D. be and the same is hereby  
opened for public travel.

And be it further enacted that all persons  
whose lands are affected by this By-Law  
who refuse to comply with the provisions thereof  
or who obstruct the carrying into effect of the  
said By-Law shall be liable to a fine on  
conviction thereof before a Justice of the Peace  
to pay a fine of not less than Five (\$5.00) dollars  
nor more than Fifty (\$50.00) dollars together  
with the full cost of suit -

And be it further enacted that all fences or  
other obstructions on said Road allowance  
be removed by the first day of July 1896
