A By-Law to pay out certain sums of money

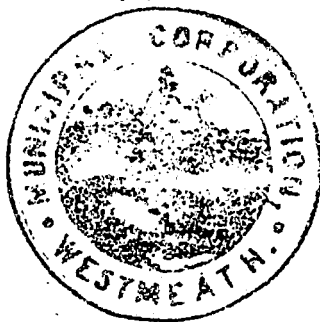
