

## By-Law No 18 1897

A By-Law to appoint four deputy returning officers to hold the election for members of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1898 and to establish the place for the nomination and for polling at said elections

Whereas it is necessary to appoint officers to hold the meeting and take the polls at the Municipal Election for the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew for the election of members of the said Council of the said Municipality for the year 1898 and to establish the place for holding the nomination of candidates and also for taking the polls at said election, it is enacted

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew by virtue and under the authority of an act of the Legislature of Ontario entitled 'An Act respecting Municipal Institutions of the Province of Ontario' enacts as follows:-

That the nomination for candidates for the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath be held in the Townhall in the village of Beachburg

That Peter Barr of the said Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said election for Electoral Division No 1 and that the Townhall Beachburg be the polling place for the said Electoral Division

That Jas Ormsby of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed

Deputy Returning Officer at said election for Electoral Division No two and that the School House in School Section no one of the said Township known as Moor's School House be the polling place for the said Electoral Division.

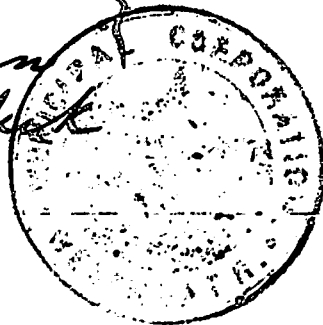
That Gideon Adams of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said election for Electoral Division No Three and that the Public Hall at Front Westmeath be the polling place for the said Electoral Division

And that George Douglas of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said election for said Electoral Division No Four and that the School in School Section No 8 known as Lee's School House be the polling place for said Electoral Division
