

By-Law No 10 1898

A By-Law to prevent Bicycles from being used on sidewalks, pathways and footpaths in the villages of Westmeath and Beachburg in the Municipality of the Township of Westmeath

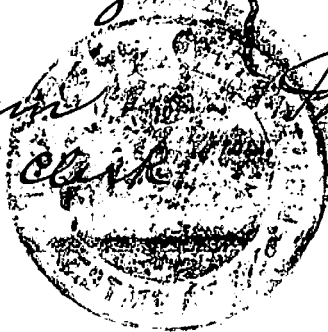
Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath that this Council prohibit the running of Bicycles on all sidewalks, pathways and footpaths in the said villages of Westmeath and Beachburg in the said Municipality of the Township of Westmeath

Be it further enacted that all persons transgressing this By-Law shall be subject to a fine of not less than one dollar nor more than ten dollars and costs

Also be it further enacted that this By-Law shall take effect on and after the 9th day of July A.D. 1898
