

B Y-L A W NO. 15 1896

To establish, maintain and regulate Lock-up-houses in the Unincorporated Villages of Beachburgh and Westmeath in the Township of Westmeath.

W H E R E A S the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew considers it advisable to establish two lock-up-houses; one at the Village of Beachburgh and one at the Village of Westmeath, both in the said Township of Westmeath Therefore the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew hereby enacts;—

(1) That a Lock-up be established in the Unincorporated Village of Beachburgh in the Township of Westmeath *in Block H Lot 55* *the land on which they are*

(2) That a Lock-up be established in the Unincorporated Village of Westmeath in the Township of Westmeath *being situated on the South part of the West half of Lot number One 4th & E.*

(3) That the work of such establishment may be proceeded with at once after the passing of this by-law, and for the purposes thereof, that the money required therefor may be raised by levy in the usual way, or by the issue of a Debenture or Debentures as the said Corporation may hereafter agree upon.

(4) That the said Lock-up houses shall be maintained and regulated by the said Corporation and shall be established, maintained and regulated for the purposes mentioned in section 520 of the Act Respecting Municipal Institutions, being Chapter
