

By-Law No. 18

To appoint a Lock-up Keeper for the Village of Beachburgh in the Township of Westmeath .

The Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew hereby enacts as follows:-

- (1) That George Strutt of the Village of Beachburgh in the Township of Westmeath is hereby appointed Lock-up Keeper and Care-Taker of the Lock-up in the said Village of Beachburgh, said appointment to commence on the ~~fourteenth~~ day of December A.D. 1898
- (2) That the said George Strutt shall receive as salary for all services performed as such lock-up keeper, Caretaker and Constable, the yearly sum of \$ 60<sup>00</sup> payable half yearly
- (3) That all fees which would otherwise be recoverable by the said George Strutt as Constable, shall belong to the said Municipal Corporation of the said Township of Westmeath, and the said George Strutt as such Constable shall do all necessary things to have said fees collected and paid over to the said Municipal Corporation, but at the costs and charges of the said Corporation (if any).
- (4) The said George Strutt as such Lock-up Keeper and Caretaker shall at all times keep the said Lock-up and premises in a good, clean and proper condition, and see that the same is properly heated when required, the said Corporation providing the fuel: he shall properly look after and keep secure all prisoners placed therein by lawful authority, and provide such prisoners from time to time with such meals as shall

be necessary and render an account for such meals at every meeting of Council, and for which he will be entitled to be paid ~~at~~ at the rate of *Twenty five* cents for each meal.

This By-Law shall come into force immediately after the passing thereof.
