

By-Law No 19 1898

A By-Law to appoint Four Deputy Returning Officers to hold the election for members of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1899 and to establish the place for the holding of the Nomination and for polling at said elections

Whereas it is necessary to appoint Officers to take the polls in case a poll be required at the Municipal Election for the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew for the Election of Members of the said Council of the said Municipality for the year 1899 and to establish the place for the holding of the nominations of candidates and also the place for taking the polls at said elections.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath by virtue and under the Authority of an act of the Legislature of Ontario entitled An Act respecting Municipal Institutions of the Province of Ontario enacts as follows:-

That the nomination for candidates for the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath be held in the Townhall in the village of Peachburg

That H. R. Dunn of the said Township be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said election for Electoral Division No 1 and that the Townhall Peachburg be the polling place for the said Electoral Division

That James Ormsby of the said Township be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said election for Electoral Division

No 2 and that the School House in School Section No 1 known as Moores School House be the polling place for said Electoral Division

That Gideon Adams of the said Township be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division No 3 and that the Public Hall at Front Watmouth be the polling place for said Division

And that George Douglas of the said Township be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Number 4 and that the School in School Section No 8 known as Lees School House be the polling place for said Electoral Division
