

By-law No. 18 1900

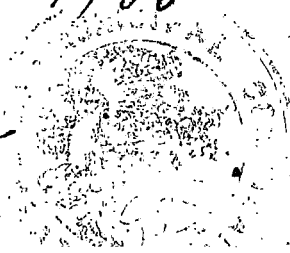
Whereas it is necessary to provide for the payment of certain sums of money
