

A By-Law to provide for Drainage work in the Village of ... Beachburgh, in the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, and for borrowing on the credit of the Municipality the sum of EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS for completing the same.

Provisionally adopted the 31<sup>st</sup> day of August A.D. 1901

W H E R E A S the majority in number of the resident and non-resident owners (exclusive of farmers' sons not actual owners) as shown by the last revised assessment Roll, of the property hereinafter set out, to be benefitted by drainage work, have Petitioned the Council of the said Township of Westmeath praying that "the area of land described as follows "All that part of the South Half of Lot number Nine in the Fifth Concession of the Township of Westmeath lying East of the registered plan of the said Village of Beachburgh; Village lots in the said Village of Beachburgh numbered 18-19-20-21-22-23 in Block E : 42-43-44 in Block F; 14-15-16-17-24-25-26 27 in Block D; 45-46-47-48 in Block G; 12-13-28-29 in Block C: 49-50-55-56 in Block H and 74 in Block K may be drained, including the highways along which the said drain is to run.

A N D W H E R E A S thereupon the said Council has procured an examination to be made by James L. Morris Esquire, Ontario Land Surveyor and Civil Engineer, being a person competent for such purpose, of the said area proposed to be drained, and the means suggested for the drainage thereof, and of the other lands and roads liable to assessment under The Municipal Drainage Act, and has also procured plans, specifications and estimates of the drainage work, to be made by the said James

L. Morris and an assessment to be made by him of the lands and roads to be benefitted by such drainage works, and of the other lands liable to contribution thereto, stating as nearly as he can, the proportion of benefit, outlet liability and injuring liability, which in his opinion will be derived or incurred in consequence of such drainage work by every road and Lot or portion of Lot; the said assessment so made being the assessment hereinafter by this By-Law enacted to be assessed and levied upon the roads and lots or parts of lots hereinafter in that behalf specially set forth and described; and the report of the said James L. Morris in respect thereof, and of the said drainage work, being as follows; - " To The Reeve & Council, Township of Westmeath. Under authority of a certified true copy of a Petition, presented to your Council July 6th. 1901, I made an inspection of the area in question, viz; - Part of the South Half of Township Lot number Nine in the Fifth concession of the Township of Westmeath, including part of the subdivided portion of the registered plan of Beachburgh Village. I found that the following drain was necessary, viz; - A glazed tile drain, commencing at the centre of the Bytown Road at the line between Township Lots 8 and 9; thence following the centre of the said road north-westerly, to an Iron bolt in the centre of the road at chainage 3x85; thence westerly and keeping a distance of eleven feet from the southerly boundary of lots 50 and 55, to an iron bolt at a stake marked 1x27; thence westerly to the Pond of the Mill Creek, at a stake marked 0x00. The above described drain is shewn on the attached plan in Red. I would recommend that a 12 inch glazed tile drain be used with connections at every lot, and that catch-basins and Manholes be built similarly as shown on plan and as described in the specifications. I estimate the cost of the drain to be \$789.35 and the proportionate

cost to each parcel of land as shewn on attached statement. I enclose Plan, Profile, Estimate and proportionate cost,

A N D W H E R E A S the said Council are of opinion that the drainage of the area described is desirable,

T H E R E F O R E the said Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath pursuant to the provisions of The Municipal Drainage Act and Amendments thereto, Enacts as follows;—

(1st) That the said Report, Plans, Specifications, Assessments and Estimates are hereby adopted, and the drainage work as therein indicated and set forth shall be made and constructed in accordance therewith.

(2nd) . The Reeve of the said Township of Westmeath may borrow on the credit of the Corporation of the said Township of Westmeath, the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars, being the funds necessary for the work, not otherwise provided for, and may issue Debentures of the Corporation aforesaid to that amount, in sums of not less than Fifty Dollars each and payable within Five years from the date hereof, with interest at the rate of Five per centum per annum, that is to say;— The amount of each Debenture and the date at which they shall be payable respectively, shall be as follows;—

each bearing interest at the said rate of 5% per annum from the date thereof, such debentures to be payable at the Bank of Ottawa in the Town of Pembroke, and to have attached to them Coupons for the payment of interest.

(3) For paying the sum of (\$259.55) the amount charged

against the said lands and roads for benefit, and the sum of (\$529.80) the amount charged against the said lands and roads for outlet liability and for covering the interest thereon for Five yearly payments thereof at the rate of Five per centum per annum, the following special rates, over and above all other .. rates, shall be assessed, levied and collected (in the same manner and at the same time as other taxes are levied and collected) upon and from the undermentioned lots and parts of lots and roads, and the amount of the said total special rates and interest against each lot or part of lot respectively, shall be divided into Five equal parts, and one of such parts shall be assessed, levied and collected as aforesaid, in each year, for Five years, after the final passing of this By-Law, during which the said Debentures have to run. The Schedule hereto annexed and marked "A" shall form part of this clause for the purposes thereof.

(4th) For the paying of the sum of (\$196.13) the amount assessed against the said roads and lands of the Municipality and for covering interest thereon for Five years at the rate of Five per centum per annum, a special rate on the dollar, sufficient to produce the yearly amount required therefor (\$45.91 as per schedule) shall, over and above all other rates, be levied and collected (in the same manner and at the same time as other taxes are levied and collected) upon and from the whole rateable property in the said Township of Westmeath in each year for five years after the final passing of this By-Law, during which the said Debentures have to run.

(5th) This By-Law shall be published once in every week for four consecutive weeks in the *Pembroke Standard* a newspaper published in the Town of Pembroke, and shall come into

force upon and after the final passing thereof, and may be cited  
as "The Beachburgh Drainage By-Law"

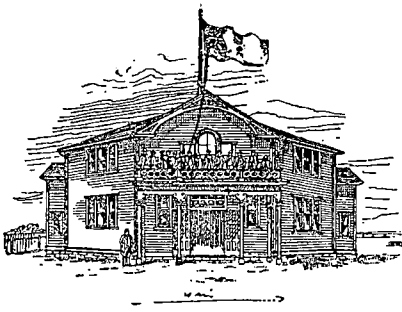
