BY-LAW NO. 24

To amend By-Law No.16 of 1901 entitled "A by-law of provide drainage works in the Village of Beachburgh in the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, and for borrowing on the credit of the Municipality the sum of Eight Hundred Doalars for completing the same "

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath on the 28th.day of September A.D.1901 passed a By-Law for the purposes above mentioned.

AND WHEREAS the said By-Law has been acted upon and the works mentioned therein undertaken and completed.

AND WHEREAS the said sum of \$800.00 provided for by the said By-Law for the said works being insufficient, the total cost of the said works being \$1017.00, it becomes necessary to pass a By-Law amending said By-Law number 16 of 1901, pursuant to section 66 of Chapter 226 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario 1897 and amending Acts to provide for the said deficiency, and also to provide for the issue of Debentures to the amount of \$217.00 to defray the balance of the cost of the said works, and in ... order to fully carry out the intention of the said original By-Law No.16 of 1901.

THEREFORE the said Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath pursuant to "The Municipal Drainage Act"and amendments thereto hereby enacts as follows;-

1. That the Reeve of the said Township may borrow on the credit of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, the sum of Two Hundred and Seventeen Dollars(\$217.00) bedng the balance of moneys required(over and above the said sum of 8800.00 already provided)for the construction and completion of the drainage works mentioned in said By-Law No.16 of 1901, and may issue Debentures of the Corporation aforesaid to that

amount, in sums of not less than \$50.00 each, payable within Four Years from the 15th.day of January A.D.1902, with interest at the rate of 5% per annum, that is to say; - the amount of each Debenture and the date at which they shall be payable respectively shall be as follows; -

1/ \$50.15 on the 15th.January A.D.1903 2/ ___\$52.96 on the 15th.January A.D.1904

\$55.80 on the 15th.January A.D.1905 and 3/ \$58.09 on the 15th.January A.D.1906..... each bearing interest at the said rate of Five per centum per annum from the date thereof; such Debentures to be payable at the Bank of Ottawa in the Town of Pembroke, and to have attached to them Coupons for the payment of interest.

For paying the said sum of \$217.00 and the interest thereon for Four yearly payments thereof at the rate of 5% per annum, the following special rate, over and above all other raxx rates, shall be assessed, levied and collected (in the same manner and at the same time as other taxes are levied and colleced)upon and from the lots and parts of lots and roads menioned and detailed in the schedule annexed and forming part of the said original By-Law No.16 of 1901, which is made part of this By-Law for the purposes hereof, and the amount of the said total special rates and interest against each lot or part of lot and road shall be divided into Four equal parts, and one of such parts shall be assessed, levied and collected as aforesaid in each year, for Four years, after the funal passing of this By-Law, during which the said Debentures have to run, the schedule hereto annexed showing the calculation, amount of Debenture, interest, annual levy and the assessments of the parties named in the said original schedule aforesaid.

For the paying of the sum of \$61.81 the amount 3. assessed against the said roads and lands of the Municipalit

and for covering the interest thereon for four years, at the .. rate of Five per centum per annum as aforesaid, a special rate on the dollar, sufficient to produce the yearly amount required therefor(\$15.45 as per schedule hereto annexed)shall, over and above all other rates, be levied and collected (in the same manner and at the same time as other taxes are levied and collected.) upon and from the whole rateable property in the said Township of Westmeath in each year for Four years after the final passing of this By-Law, during which the said Debentures have to run...

4. This By-Law shall come into force on the 2nd.day of January A.D.1902, and may be cited as "The Beachburgh Drainage Amending By-Law"

To amend By-Law No.16 of 1901 entitled "A by-law (pprovide drainage works in the Village of Beachburgh in the Township of Jestmenth in the County of Renfrew, and for borrowing on the credit of the Junicipality the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars for completing the same "

AHEIMAS the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Jestmeath on the 28th.day of September A.J.1901 passed a By-Law for the purposes above montioned.

AND WHEREAS the said By-Law has been acted upon and the works mentioned therein undertaken and completed.

AND HEREAS the said sum of $\sqrt{800.00}$ provided for by the said By-Law for the said works being insufficient, the total cost of the said works being $\sqrt[3]{1017.00}$, it becomes necessary to pass a By-Law smending said By-Law number 16 of 1901, pursuant to section 66 of Chapter 226 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario 1857 and amending (cts to provide for the said deficiency, and also to provide for the issue of Debentures to the amount of $\sqrt{217.000}$ to defray the balance of the cost of the said works, and in ... order to fully carry out the intention of the said original By-Law No.16 of 1901.

2/ \$52.96 on the 15th. January A.D. 1904

For paying the said sum of 3217.00 and the interest 2. thereon for Four yearly payments thereof at the rate of 5% per annum, the following special rate, over and above all other xxxx rates, shall be assessed, lovied and collected (in the same manner and at the same time as other taxes are levied and collected)upon and from the lots and parts of lots and roads mentioned and detailed in the schedule annexed and forming part of the said original By-Law No.16 of 1901, which is made part of this By-Law for the purposes hereof, and the amount of the said total special rates and interest against each lot or part of lot and road shall be divided into Your equal parts, and one of such parts shall be assessed, levied and collected as aforesaid in each year, for Four years, after the funal passing of this By-Law, during which the said Debentures have to run, the schedule hereto annexed showing the calculation, amount of Debenture, interest, annual levy and the assessments of the parties named in the said original schedule aforesaid.

For the paying of the sum of \$61.81 the amount assessed against the said roads and lands of the Cunicipalit and for covering the interest thereon for four years, at the ... rate of Five per centum per annum as aforesaid, a special rate on the dollar, sufficient to produce the yearly amount required therefor(\$15.45 as per schedule heroto annexed) shall, over and above all other rates, be levied and collected (in the same manner and at the same time as other taxes are levied and collected)upon and from the whole rateable property in the said Township of destmeath in each year for Four years after the final passing of this By-Law, during which the said Debentures have to **m**un....
