

Bylaw No. 9, 1902

A Bylaw to appoint certain Township Officers for the year 1902

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath that on and after that the persons herein after mentioned as Fenceviewers and Pound Keepers for the several Divisions of the Municipality of Westmeath be and they are hereby constituted and appointed to fill the said respective <sup>offices</sup> as set forth in the Schedules hereunto annexed marked A & B.

That each of the said officers hereby appointed shall on or before the first day of May next after the passing of this Bylaw make and subscribe the necessary declaration of office and shall continue to hold such respective offices as aforesaid until his or their successors in office have been appointed.
