

Bylaw No. 14 1902

Bylaw for regulating and licensing Exhibitions of wax work, Menageries, circus riding, Merry-go-rounds, and other such like shows in the Township of Westmeath

And whereas the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath deem it advisable to pass such Bylaw.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath

1. That the Mayor or Clerk of the Council may authorize the holding of Exhibitions of wax work, Menageries, circus riding Merry-go-rounds and all such like shows usually exhibited by showmen within the Municipality and grant licenses therefor
2. That every person obtaining such license shall pay the said Clerk a license fee of ten dollars per diem for each day that such exhibition is held
3. That any person or persons infringing this Bylaw or holding such exhibition within the Municipality without such license being first had and obtained and such license fee being first paid shall be liable to a fine of not less than twenty dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each such offence upon conviction thereof before one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the County of Newry and that it shall and may be lawful for such convicting Justice by warrant

under his hand and seal to levy the said
fine and costs by distress and sale
of the goods and chattels of such showmen
or belonging to or used in such exhibition
whether owned by such showmen or not
or to imprison any such person or persons
infringing this Bylaw in the Common Jail
of the County of Newfane for a period of
one month

4. That the Schedule A hereunder written
shall be the form of license under this
Bylaw
