Whereas it is necessary to pay out certain sums of money

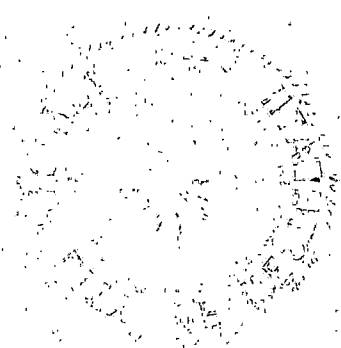
