A. Bylaw to appoint Road overseers during the winter months of 1903

And whereas it is necessary to appoint by Bylaw certain Road overseers during the winter months

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath as follows

1st That the Township be divided into fifteen beats or sections and the boundaries of each section to be the ^{same as the} boundaries of ^{each of the} several school sections in the Township, one overseer over each section or beat

2nd Each overseer is to see that the roads in his division are kept in a reasonable state of repair and open for travel as soon as possible after every snow storm for the performance of said work he is to receive 25 cents per hour for a man and team and 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ cents per hour for man to shovel and if necessary to call out help at same rate and keep account of time necessarily spent at work on roads and to furnish a statement to this Council at spring meeting Payment for work to be credited to ^{overseer} ~~man~~ and anyone else employed by him on account of taxes for this year
