Concession, and to open and establish a road in lieu thereof elsevhere across the said lots, and the said Council are willing to accede to the prayer of the said Petition.
$A N D$ WHEREAS notice of the intention of this Council to close the said road was posted up in six of the most public places In the immediate neighbourhood of the said road, on the l7th. day of July A.D. 1903 (more than one month prior to the final passing of this by-law)and in which notice is the intimation that the said Councilintended to pass this byalaw at a sitting to be held at the Village of Beachburgh in said Township on the $25 t h$ day of August A.D. 1903 at $100^{\prime}$ Clocks in the forenoon.
$A N D$ WHEREAS THE NOTICE IN THE LAST RECITAL MENTIONED was published weekly, for Four successive weeks in the Pembroke Standard, weekly newspaper published in the Town of Fembroke, being a neighbouring Municipality(there being no newspaper published in the said Township of Westmeath)more than One month prior to the date given for the passing of this byelaw, to wit, on the 15th. 22nd and 29th.days of July and the 5th. day of sugust 1903, of the intention of the said Council to pass this by-law on the 25 th. day of August 1903 at a place, date and hour named in the said notice. $A$ A D $\quad$ H $\mathrm{H} R \mathrm{R}$ AS no person, whose lands might be prejudicially affected by the passing of this bymlaw, appeared before said Council at the said sitting, either personally or by Solicitor petitioning to be heard, as he had a right to do under the statute

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH hereby enacts as follows;

1. 2. That this by maw shall come into effect upon the passing thereof.
