

Bylaw No. 22, 1903

A Bylaw to appoint four Deputy Returning Officers to hold the Election for members of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1904 and to establish the place for holding the nomination and for polling at the said Elections

And whereas it is necessary to appoint officers to take the Polls in case a Poll is required at the Municipal Elections for the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew for the Election of members of the said Council of the said Municipality for the year 1904 and to establish the place for the holding of the nominations of Candidates and also the place for taking the Polls at said Elections

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath by virtue and under the Authority of an Act of the Legislature of Ontario entitled an Act respecting Municipal Institutions of the Province of Ontario enact as follows:-

1<sup>st</sup> That the nomination of Candidates for the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath be held in the Town Hall in the village of Beasburg according to statute in that behalf

2<sup>nd</sup> That Samuel Wright Esq. of the said Township be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division No. 1. and that Beasburg be the Polling place for said Electoral Division

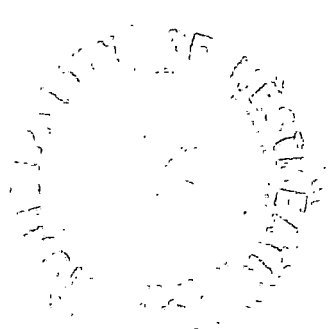
3<sup>rd</sup> That James Donohy of the said Township  
be and he is hereby appointed Deputy  
Returning Officer at said Election for  
Electoral Division No. 2, and that the  
School House on S. V. No. 1. (Known as  
Moore School House) be the Polling  
place for the said Electoral Division

4<sup>th</sup> That Gideon Adams of the said  
Township be and he is hereby appointed  
Deputy Returning Officer at said election  
for Electoral Division No. 3, and that  
the Public Hall at Westmeath village  
be the Polling place for said Electoral  
Division

5<sup>th</sup> And that George Douglas of the said  
Township of Westmeath be and he is  
appointed Deputy returning officer  
at said Election for Electoral Division  
No. 4, and that the School House known  
as Lees School House be the Polling place  
for said Electoral Division

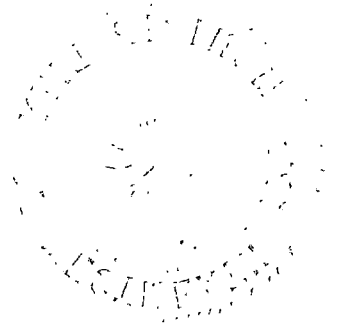
