

A By Law to assess and levy rates or taxes for County, Township and General and <sup>Public</sup> school purposes.

It therefore be it enacted by the municipal corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Kenilworth that the following sums be levied and collected upon and from all the rateable property in the Township of Westmeath for the year of our Lord 1905:

County

1st - The sum of 2458.98 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the said Township of Westmeath for County purposes for the year 1905 by a rate of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  mills on the dollar.

Township

2nd - The sum of 2970<sup>00</sup> is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the Township of Westmeath for Township purposes for the year 1905 by a rate of  $1\frac{7}{10}$  mills on the dollar.

General School

3rd - The sum of \$2300<sup>00</sup> is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property of the said Township of Westmeath for General school purposes for the year 1905 by a rate of  $1\frac{2}{5}$  mills on the dollar.

4th - and it is further enacted that the following sums shall be levied upon and collected from all the rateable property in the said Township of Westmeath, included within the limits of the several school sections herein after mentioned respectively for the year 1905:-

and be it further enacted that the rates imposed by this by-law shall be collected and paid over to the Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in bankable funds on or before the 15th day of December 1905- by the collector of rates for the said Township of Westmeath in as far as the law will enable him to do so.
