

Bylaw No 22. 1906

A. Bylaw to appoint four Deputy Returning Officers to hold the elections for Members of The Municipal Corporation of The Township of Westmeath for the year 1907 and to establish the places for holding the nomination and for polling at the said elections

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows:-

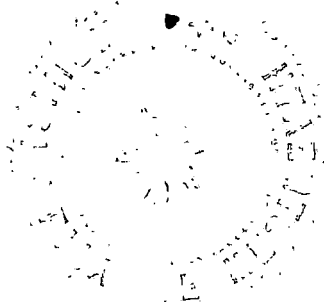
- 1st. That the nomination of candidates for the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath be held in the Town Hall in the Village of Beacomb according to statute in that behalf
- 2nd. That Peter Barr of the said Township be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at said Election for Electoral Division No. 1. and that the Town Hall at Beacomb be the polling place for said Electoral Division
- 3rd. That William Smyth of the said Township be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Sub-division No. 2. and that the School House in School Section No. 1. (Known as Moore's School House) be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division
- 4th. That Gideon Adams of the said Township be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Sub-division No. 3. and that the Public Hall at Westmeath Village be the Polling place for said Electoral Division

5th That George Douglas of the said Township
of Westmeath be and he is hereby appointed
deputy Returning Officer at said election
for Electoral Division No. 4, and that
the school house in school section No. 8
(known as Lee's school house) be the polling
place for said Electoral Division
