

Bylaw No. 2, 1907

A Bylaw to appoint Road Overseers during the winter months of 1907

And whereas it is necessary to appoint by Bylaw certain Road Overseers during the winter months

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath as follows:-

- 1st. That the Township be divided into fifteen beats or divisions the boundaries of each section to be the same as each of the several sections in the Township
- One Overseer over each section or beat
- 2nd. Each Overseer to see that the roads on his division are kept in a reasonable state of repair and open for travel as soon as possible after every snow storm. For the performance of said work he is to receive the sum of $12\frac{1}{2}$ cents ^{per hour} for one man and the sum of 25 cents per hour for man and team and if necessary to call out help at same rate and keep account of time necessarily spent at work on roads and to furnish a statement to this Council at its April meeting
