And whereas it is necessary to pass a Bylaw to pay out certain sums of money

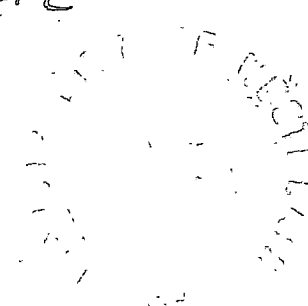
