

Bylaw No. 10. 1908

A Bylaw to assess and levy rates and taxes for County, Township, General and Public School purposes

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew that the following sums be levied and collected on and from all the rateable property in the Township of Westmeath for the year 1908

1st. The sum of \$3040.⁰⁷ is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the said Township of Westmeath for County purposes for the year 1908 by a rate of $1\frac{3}{4}$ mills on the \$

2nd. The sum of \$1737.⁸⁵ is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the Township of Westmeath for Township purposes for the year 1908 by a rate of 1 mills on the \$

3rd. That the sum of \$4850.⁰⁰ is hereby levied and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the Township of Westmeath for General School Purposes for the year 1908 by a rate of $2\frac{3}{4}$ mills on the \$

4th. And it is further enacted that the following sums shall be levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the said Township of Westmeath included within the limits of the several School Sections hereinafter mentioned respectively for the year 1908
