

Bylaw Number 15 1909

As Bylaw of the Municipality of the Township of Westmeath to improve the main and leading roads within the said Municipality

Whereas it is desired to improve the main or leading roads of the Township of Westmeath, by grading, draining, gravelling, or other work of a substantial character, at a total estimated cost of \$1600⁰⁰/₁₀₀

And whereas by an act of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario 7 Edward VIII Chapter 17, being an Act respecting Colonization Roads, certain Township may prepare and approve a Bylaw designating any highway or highways to be improved in accordance with the regulations of the Public Works Department. The said Township of Westmeath, being one of such Townships described in the said act

And whereas upon the completion of any such work of improvement, the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council, upon the recommendation of the Minister of Public Works, may direct that a sum being not ^{more} less than two thirds of the estimated cost may be paid to the Municipality out of any appropriation made by the Legislative Assembly for that purpose

Westmeath enacts as follows:-

No 1 - That the highways to be improved under this bylaw and the amount to be expended for each shall be: No 1 Commencing at the Town line between the Townships of Pembroke and Westmeath. Easterly along the Main and Leading Road from the Townships of Ross and Westmeath to the Town of Pembroke, through lots 27 and 26 Range B. thence through lot 25 and part of lot 24 Range A. a distance of 1 mile - \$ 500⁰⁰/₇₇

No 2 - On the same Leading Road passing through lot 10 concession 4 East of the Muskrat Lake three quarters of one mile, the sum of ~~three~~ ^{two} hundred dollars

No 3. On the Road leading from Beachburg to the Roche Fenner on the side road between lots 5 and 6 concession six East of the Muskrat Lake a distance of one mile, the sum of three hundred dollars.

No 4 Commencing at McDonald's Hill Easterly along the Lower line opposite lots seven and eight concession 4. Coulouge Lake front a distance of one mile, the sum of three hundred dollars

No 5 - Commencing at the Town line between the Townships of Ross and Westmeath, northerly, along the concession line between concessions

one and two West of the Inverloch
Lake (being the main and leading
road between the village of Inverloch
and the town of Pembroke through the
Township of Westmeath) Opposite
lots one, two, and one half of no three
a distance of one mile, the
sum of one mill, the sum of
three hundred dollars.

2nd

The Reeve and Clerk of the said
Municipality of the Township of
Westmeath, shall prepare a copy
of this Bylaw and submit the
same, to the Minister of Public
Works, and shall request a grant
of two thirds of the estimated cost
of the said works, ^{such grant} not to exceed the
sum of One thousand and sixty seven
dollars
