

Bylaw No 40 1910

A Bylaw to impose a charge of certain percentages on all Rates and taxes remaining unpaid after certain dates mentioned therein

Whereas Chapter 23 Section 102 of the Ontario Statutes 1904 Empowers Municipal Councils of Townships, to impose a percentage charge, (not exceeding 5 percent) on all Rates and taxes remaining unpaid after certain day or days named by them

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows

That a percentage charge of two percent shall be imposed on all taxes remaining unpaid after the ~~thirty first~~ ^{thirtieth} day of December in every year

And a further percentage of Three percent after the Thirty first day of January so that the whole percentage do not exceed five percent

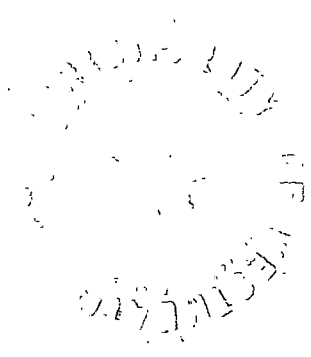
And that the collector shall have full power to collect such percentages of Two and Five percent respectively in the
