

Bylaw No 46 1910

A Bylaw to appoint four Deputy-Returning Officers to hold the Elections for members of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1910 and to establish the places for holding the nomination and for polling at the said election

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows

1st That the nomination of candidates for the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath, be held in the Town Hall Beachburg according to the statute in that behalf

2nd That Peter Burr of the said Township be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer, at the said election for Electoral District No 1 and that the Town Hall at Beachburg be the polling place for the said Electoral Division

3rd That William Smyth of the said Township be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for polling subdivision No 2 and that the School House in School Section No 1 (Known as Moores School) be the polling place for the said Electoral Division

4th That Gideon Adams of the said Township be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling subdivision No 3 and that the Public Hall in Westmeath Village be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division

5th That George Douglas of the said Township be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for subdivision No 4 and that the School House in

Schol Section No 8 (Known as Lee's
School House) be the polling place
for the said Electoral Division
